

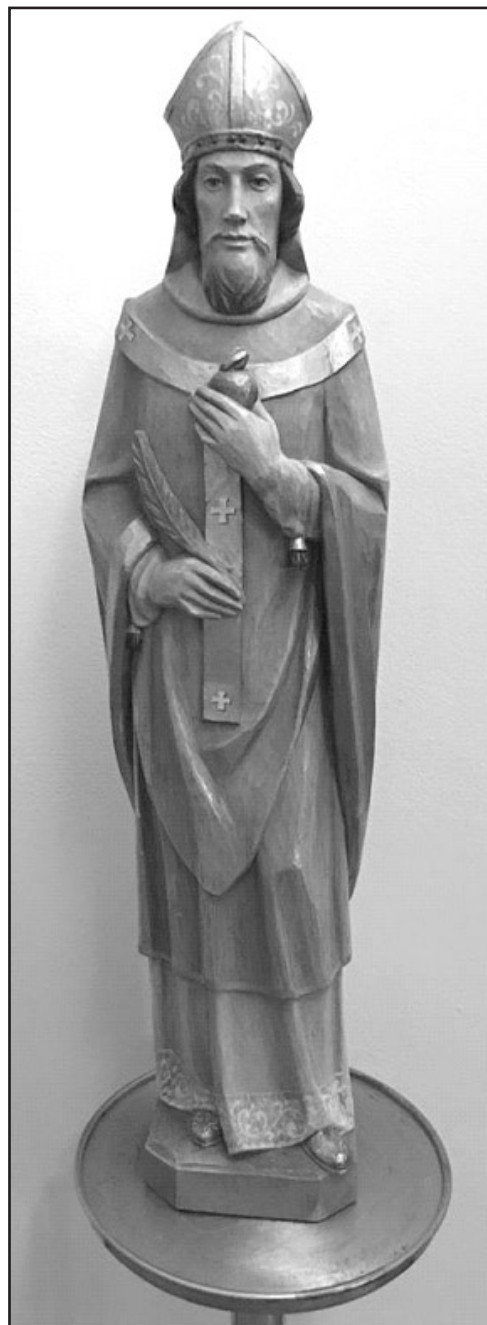

**PASTOR'S DESK**

**October 18, 2020 – 29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

*“Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s and to God the things that are God’s.” - Matthew 22:21*

Everything we are and everything we have belongs to God. We aren’t “owners” of anything, we are merely “stewards” of the gifts God has given each of us. All God is asking is that we give back a portion of what He gave us. This is the essence of Stewardship. God should be our first priority in everything. All else comes second, especially our money.

**Financial update:** We are now in the third quarter of the calendar year; on our way to the end of the year, in the midst of a pandemic! We are very fortunate here my friends that we have very few expenses, at St Augustine parish. We are blessed to receive from collections which include about 40/45 envelopes per week. We are grateful for your donations and keeping us on track to pay our bills. A number of people are truly generous. At beginning of January there were 150 envelope boxes disbursed. Please note we average about \$2,500 dollars to \$3,000 dollars per week.

**Beyond the hour on Sunday:** As you heard last week on the "invitation" to the wedding banquet (Gospel of Matthew) “Have you invited anyone lately to mass? I think we are beyond the point of focusing on clergy or Religious sisters to be the ones, the catalysts for welcoming the stranger, the inquirer, the neighbour who may be wondering about the Faith. ALL the baptized has a responsibility in building the Christian Community. Do you have anyone wishing to be Baptized and/or become RC? How are we at St. Augustine parish? What is its future?
