

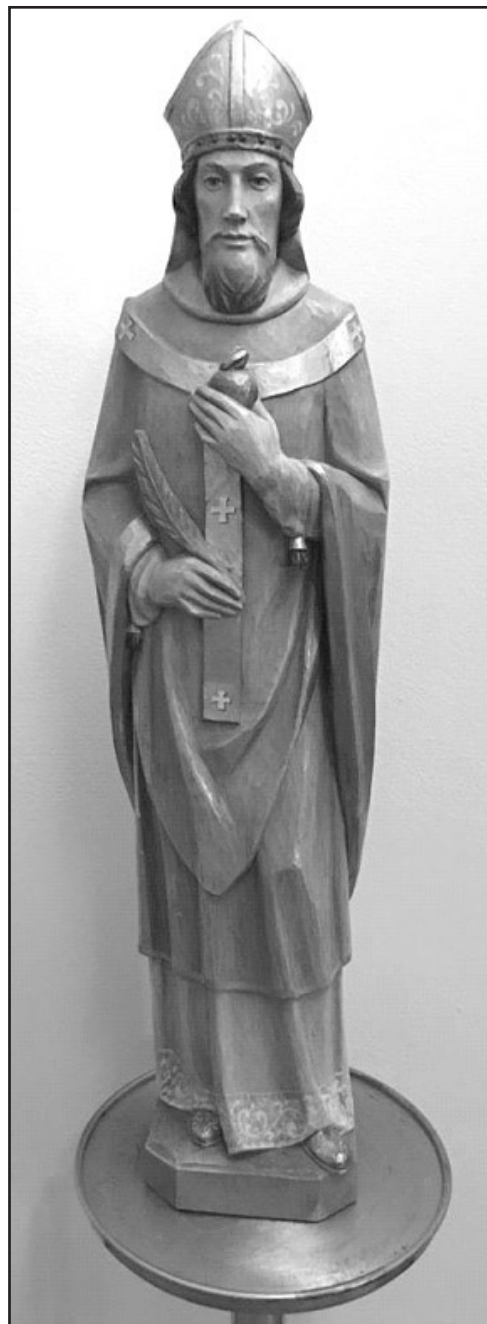

October 21, 2018 - Twenty Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many.” MARK 10:45

If you held a mirror up to your life, would it reflect God’s love and mercy? If you are struggling with this, try changing your attitude from “I want more” to “thank you God for everything you have given me, I have enough to share”. This change in perspective will bring you joy through service to others.

Beyond the hour on Sunday ... more and more the safeguarding of minors and vulnerable adults has become the focus lately in a revised policy. The Ottawa Archdiocese took a proactive decision to put even more emphasis on safeguarding our pastoral environments and protecting all members of our community, especially minors and vulnerable adults. We set up a new Diocesan Safe Environment Office (DSEO) with a full-time lay employee. The first priorities of the DSEO have been to review and update our policies and procedures for safe screening, supervising, monitoring, reporting and investigating abuse claims. In addition, the Office is preparing an intensive program of training and education. Our recent pastoral day (Oct.11) for all pastors and volunteers in parishes highlighted this important part of parish life and ministry.

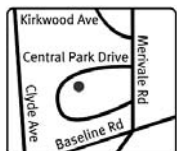
