

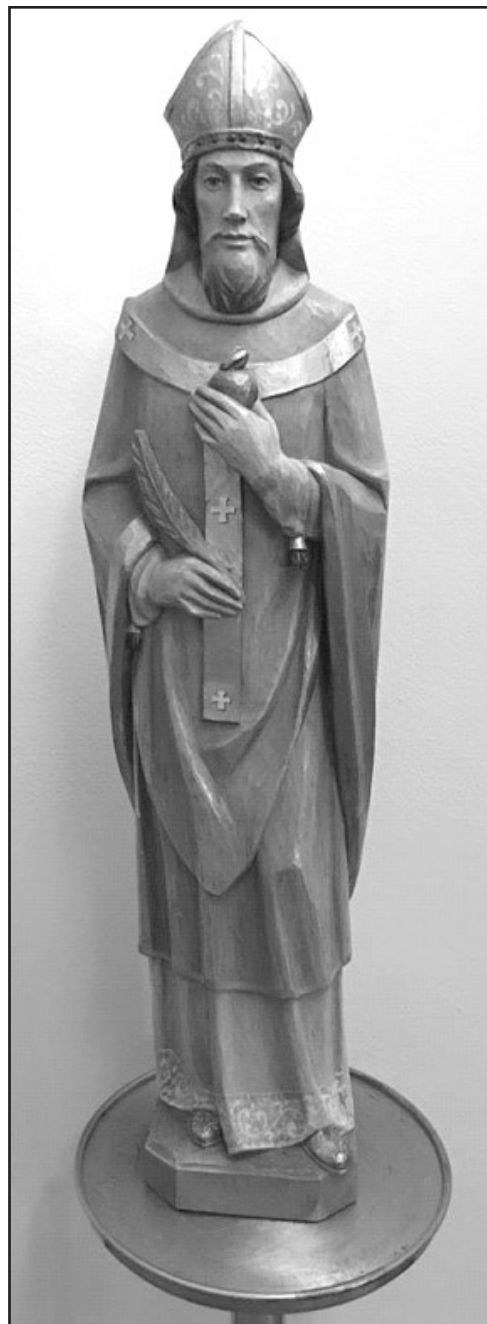

**New Evangelization** workshop will be launched here in the parish from **Fri., Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> to Sun., Nov. 4<sup>th</sup>**. The workshop will start Friday evening in the church at 7 p.m. Michael Dopp, who spoke at all masses on Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>, will be the facilitator to engage all participants on *How does Evangelization work in the parish setting?* All those who are co-ordinators and leaders of ministry, committees and members of parish councils here in the parish are urged to attend. Some neighbouring parishes have been invited. This time together will explore how we can best offer our time and talent in building the Christian Community here at St. Augustine's.

**Weekday Mass time changes effective Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>**, as we go back to 9:00 a.m. (until May 1<sup>st</sup>). Please note church is open at 7:15 a.m. for Holy hour and adoration and rosary at 8:30 a.m.

**Bible study continues on the first Wednesday and third Wednesday of each month.** Join us on **Wed., Nov. 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., in the parish boardroom.** We will be focusing on the Gospel of Mark.

**Cannibis reaction:** The Bishops of Canada's reaction to recent legalization of Cannibis, is that it will have "disastrous effects". The recent Catholic register (online) further expresses the Bishops concern... *“The massive increase in cannabis use that will accompany its legalization will not produce a more just and humane society,” the bishops wrote, “But will only exacerbate or multiply problems already widespread in society, including mental illness, crime, unemployment, family breakdown, injuries and fatalities resulting from impaired driving, and increased addiction to “harder” drugs along with associated problems resulting from overdose.”* Check out the CCCB website at: <http://www.cccb.ca>. There is no question all those under 25 continuing to use cannibis will have health risk and serious reaction over time to continued recreational use.

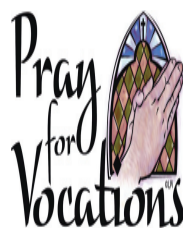

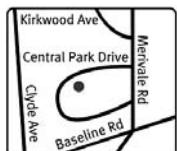
