From the Pastor's Desk

Sunday (October 4): "What God has joined together, let no man put asunder" What is God's intention for our state in life, whether married or single? Jesus deals with the issue of divorce by taking his hearers back to the beginning of creation and to God's plan for the human race. In Genesis 2:23-24 we see God's intention and ideal that two people who marry should become so indissolubly one that they are one flesh. That ideal is found in the unbreakable union of Adam and Eve. They were created for each other and for no one else. They are the pattern and symbol for all who were to come. Jesus explains that Moses permitted divorce as a *concession* in view of a lost ideal. "Lord Jesus Christ, your call to holiness extends to all in every state of life. Sanctify our lives - as married couples and as singles - that we may live as men and women who are consecrated to you. Make us leaven in a society that disdains life-long marriage fidelity, chastity, and living single for the Lord".

1st Reading: Genesis 2.7ab, 15, 18-24
The two become one flesh.

2nd Reading: Hebrews 2.9-11
For the one who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one Father.

Gospel: Mark 10.2-16
What God has joined together, let no man separate.

Some thoughts from last week's

homily: If I were to write a mathematical equation for this week's readings, (Gospel Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48) I think it would look like this: TC + GH - J. Start with "tender compassion" toward those who are poor or suffering in any way. Add "gentle humility" regarding our own favourite spiritual paths, and subtract "judgement" of those who look, act or think differently than we do. TC + GH - J just might be the formula for healthy discipleship that Jesus is calling us to embrace today!

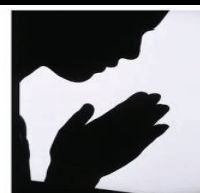
