

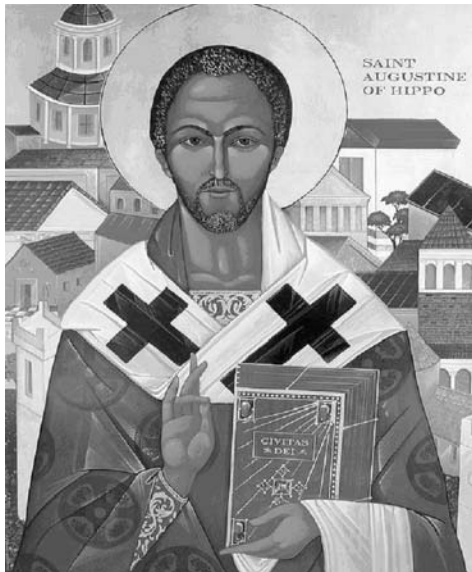

"Lord, increase our faith!"

"How strong is your faith in God and how can you grow in it? Faith is not something vague, uncertain, indefinable, or something which requires a leap of the imagination or worse, some kind of blind allegiance. In fact, it is quite the opposite. Faith is a response of trust and belief in what is reliable, truthful, certain, and real. To have faith is to believe and trust in someone or something.
