September 23, 2018 - Twenty Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**“If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all.” MARK 9:35**

Jesus teaches us that we are called to serve one another. Sacrifice is not a word that many people like to hear. We think it means that we must give up something that we want. However, the literal meaning of sacrifice is “to make holy,” from the words “*sacer*” = *sacred* and “*facere*” = *to make*. In other words, we make our lives holy by sharing our gifts in the service of God.

**Evangelization** must be *more about helping people to fall in love than about convincing them to fall in line*. “The most important thing,” Pope Francis said, “is the first proclamation: Jesus Christ has saved you.” In what ways can we discover and empower people to understand their faith in a deeper way. Next Sunday at all masses we welcome Michael Dopp who will speak on this topic, and related themes. Michael will be here early November to facilitate a workshop, “ways and means/equipping” the parish to implement the New Evangelization.

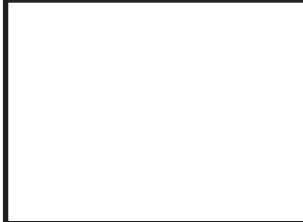

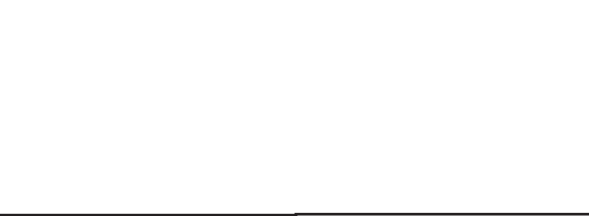
