

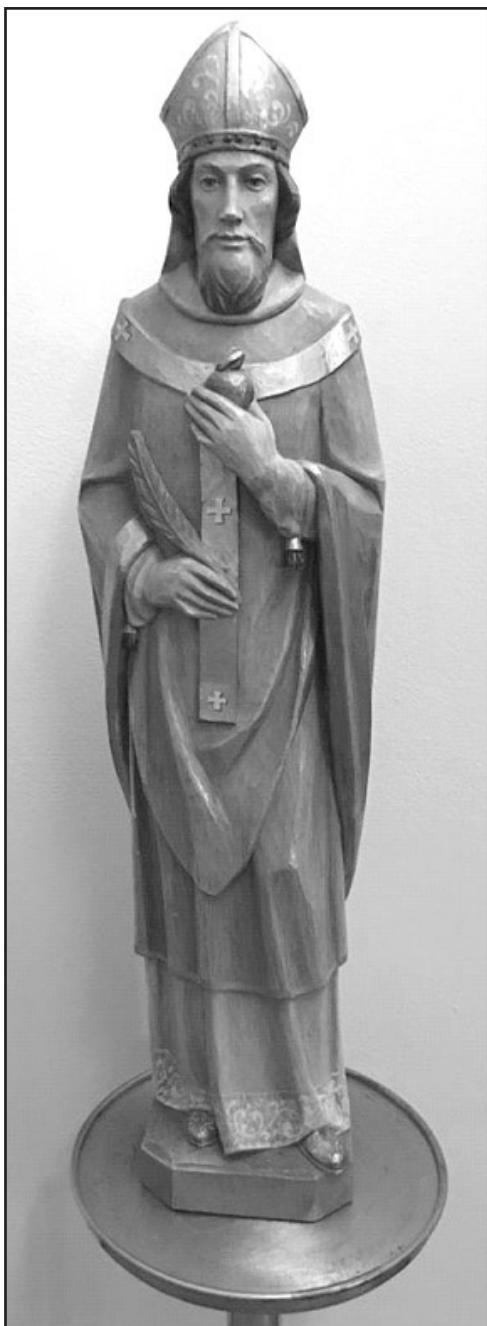

PASTOR'S DESK**September 4, 2022 - 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time**

“Everyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple.” Luke 14:33

When we first hear this statement, it seems that Jesus is making an unrealistic demand upon us. How can we renounce all of our possessions? We need them to live. However, what we must renounce is the belief that they belong to us. Everything that we have belongs to God alone. All of our resources are entrusted to us not only for our own use, but also so that we can help others. Once we renounce the idea that we possess or are entitled to anything, it is much easier to share the many gifts that God has given us. Then we truly are His Disciples.

Beyond the Hour on Sunday:

We look forward to a new pastoral year! Hopefully more parishioners will be back to celebrate Sunday mass. We anticipate more volunteers for ministries and the Knights of Columbus. We pray that we do not have another active round of Covid to disrupt parish life. As part of our calling as disciples; we are challenged to bring someone to church, to RCIA, to the Sacraments; as ambassadors for Christ ... like we hear in the Gospel "pointing others to Christ." Do you know of any adults who are not Baptized or who have not been Confirmed? Please call or check with Father Frank.

Postures, gestures at Sunday Liturgy:

What or why do we do what we do at Mass? For some time now we have been used to having "shared silence" after the homily and after Communion to contemplate what we just received. Like in all liturgies "shared silence" is vital, much like in prayer time itself. You will notice when people come for Adoration of Blessed Sacrament before weekday mass, some may prostrate, deep bow or genuflect to signify what we are doing and WHO this is for. When we enter from the west side of the church here at St. Augustine's, it is very important to genuflect to the tabernacle, to the presence of Eucharist in the Blessed Sacrament chapel. Also, we are to be reminded of a short bow when coming toward Communion; making this special gesture before such a gift we receive. *Become What You Receive In the Gospel from John 6, Jesus proclaims to the people, “I am the bread of life.” (John 6: 24-35). Pope St. Leo the Great affirms that, by partaking of the body and blood of Christ, we are changed into what we receive.*
