Pastoral Reflections

On this fifth Sunday of Lent, we reflect on the theme: **Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life**. Today we hear the gospel story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the death. We listen to the grief of Martha, Mary and their friends over the death of Lazarus. It is the deep faith in Jesus that transforms – a sad moment – into a resurrected life-giving presence of Lazarus raised by Jesus – a journey of coming out of the tomb.

We all might have an experience of someone dying in our family or our friends. The experience of death is painful and devastating but as Christians we believe that death is not the end of life's journey rather the beginning of our life in heaven.

This season of lent may be a time for us to listen to the words of Jesus – calling us – Come out of the tomb – a tomb of sadness, selfishness or sinfulness – then we can have that resurrected moment of life and love in Jesus.

It is only in Jesus that we find true meaning in our life and fulfillment of our call to love. Let death and decay have no place in our spiritual life, so that we may be always vibrant and alive in our faith and all may believe in Jesus.

Let's allow Jesus to fulfill Ezekiel's prophecy of – 'opening-up our graves' who through the spirit dwells within us, can raise us now here in the present life and after our earthily death into eternal life.

Lord, I believe you are the resurrection and life.

Evening Prayer and Lectio Divina


