

2020: Year of Joy - Month of February: Marriage and Consecrated Life



In 2014, on the 50th anniversary of Proclamation of the *Lumen Gentium*, Pope Francis in his address to the consecrated life, he invited all faithful to reflect on the universal Call to Holiness. He explained some of the Aims of the Year of Consecrated Life is “to look to the past with gratitude, to live in the present with passion, and to embrace the future with hope.” He invited everyone “to wake up the world, since the distinctive sign of consecrated life is prophecy. “Radical evangelical living is not only for religious: it is demanded of everyone.

But religious follow the Lord in a special way, in a prophetic way.” This is the priority that is needed right now: “to be prophets who witness to how Jesus lived on this earth... a religious must never abandon prophecy” During this year of Joy and I invite you to reflect on your consecrated life. We are consecrated in our baptism and received the call to Holiness. Let us keep awake and wake up the world with justice, peace and love. In a concrete way, I invite you to take time to reflect on your life, your faith journey of life, if possible to read a book and go for a retreat or spiritual direction.

Marriage Sunday on February 8/9, 2020

Marriage Sunday highlights the importance of the sacrament of marriage and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America.

The Celebration of Marriage Mass will take place **on Sunday, February 9, 2020** at **St. Isaac Jogues Parish** (1148 Finch Avenue, Pickering) at **3:00 p.m.**. Cardinal Thomas Collins will preside over this special Mass where all are welcome to attend and married couples will have an opportunity to renew their vows. Please note that everyone wishing to attend is required to register before the **deadline of February 4, 2020** to secure a seat. All married couples are invited to attend; however, reserved seating will be available **only** for couples celebrating their milestone 25th, 40th, 50th and 60+ wedding anniversaries. Non-reserved seating will be provided on a first-come first-served basis to all other married couples, family members, friends and others attending the Mass (doors open at 2 p.m.).
