A message from Cardinal Thomas Collins on Marriage Sunday

February 7, 2016

To Married Couples throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto,

On the occasion of Marriage Sunday in the Archdiocese of Toronto, I wish to affirm all married couples who inspire us through their daily witness of fidelity and faithfulness. Your commitment serves as a beacon of hope that strengthens our faith community in so many different ways.

In the fall of 2015, I participated in the Synod of the Family at the Vatican. Bishops, priests, religious and lay people, including married couples from around the world, gathered to speak of the importance of the family, their joys and the many struggles facing the family in today's world. In a society that often suggests life-long commitment is impossible, many see marriage as counter-cultural. That is why it is so important for the church to affirm and support couples who say "yes" each day to their relationship.

Our discussions at the Synod on the Family included strategies on how, in addition to our prayerful support, the church can assist those who have suffered from the pain of a broken relationship or loss of a spouse. In our own archdiocese, we have numerous programs in place to provide marriage enrichment, counselling and pastoral care. We also recognize the need to inspire and educate those preparing for marriage. In speaking to young couples in 2013, Pope Francis said: "Do not be afraid to take steps which are permanent, like getting married: deepen your love by respecting its seasons and expressions, pray, prepare yourselves well; and then trust that the Lord will not leave you alone! Let him come into your home like one of the family, He will always sustain you!"

Be assured of my prayers and admiration for all married couples across the Archdiocese of Toronto. May God continue to bless your marriage as you grow together in love.
