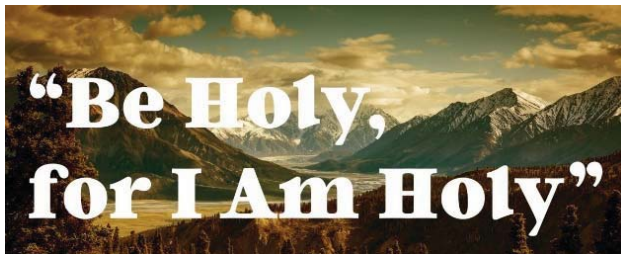

The Highlights of St. Ann Parish Stewardship Ministry Report of 2020

On behalf of the Parish community of St. Ann and Native Peoples' Mission, I would like to thank you for your support, ministry and contributions during most difficult times in 2020. With the 24 Ministry groups, we are keeping faith alive and service active in helping our brothers and sisters in our society.

St. Ann Food Bank: With the help and commitment of 24 courageous volunteers, we kept the food bank open and at present we serve 325 individuals a week, that is more than 15,000 people a year in our community. We have begun the new mission of distributing warm clothes and feeding the homeless.

St. Ann Liturgy: In spite of the closing of the church for most of the year, the installation of a camera has enabled us to celebrate all the daily and Sunday liturgies with live streaming. We connected everyone through emails and Social Media.

Holy Cross Family Ministries – Canada: has helped us to continue to support youth and families. We have made 35,000 rosaries by hand. We have encouraged reading the Bible through the Bible Project and we continue to visit the sick at Bridgepoint Hospital.

St Ann Youth Group: We continue to support youth of Toronto. With their help, we have published **10 YouTube videos on the Life of St. Joseph** and the daily **Online Masses**. We promote discernment for the youth via prayer group -faith formation talks, Bible Reflections and Adoration

Renovations: With your donations, we were able to complete 2 major renovations projects: **Foodbank Storage Rooms** and new pavement of the **Parking Lot**. These projects help us to be safe and effective in our food donation distribution.

Please join us so that *"no one is left alone"* during this pandemic times. Thank you for your generous donations. 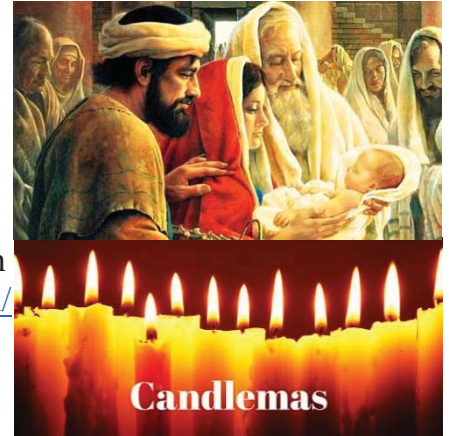

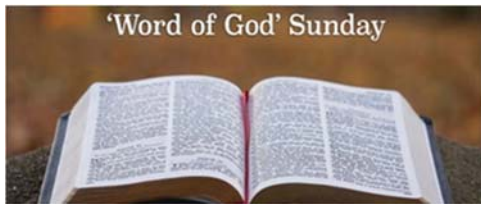
Family Prayer – 2021: “Lord, Teach us to pray”
