Please do keep the family in your prayers so we can help in resettling the family in Canada.

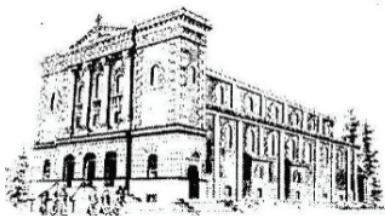
Catholic Women's League of Canada

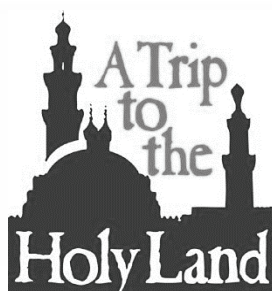
