

**Pentecost: Come Holy Spirit, Come**  
**Pastoral Reflections**

*Veni Sancte Spiritus* Come, Holy Spirit, come! Today we gloriously sing this sequence during the liturgy. This is a call of community to fill us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit so that we can sing with the psalmist praying: **“Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.”** It is a call to renew the face of the earth – our home. How can we truly bring about renewal in our personal life, our family, our community, our city, country and the entire earth?



**Our world is a place where we live, where God intended for us to live in love and peace, where we can experience freedom and safety. Yet we see and hear in the everyday news– violence of all sorts, misfortunes, relationship break-ups, calamities, and people living in fear and pain. How can this earth be renewed? Can the words of Jesus: “Peace be with you,” be truly felt in our world of today? How can we, the Disciples of Christ be real instruments of the peace of Christ?**

Before we begin to change the world we need to change ourselves. We need to pray every day asking the Holy Spirit to guide us with the wisdom and love. With the help of the Holy Spirit we can overcome our fears, our unforgiving attitudes, our selfishness, our laziness, self-pity, and ignorance. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we can be open to that renewal and newness of life. We will then realize that we are part of the whole body of Christ. 


