

2021: The Call to Holiness



Call to Holiness: Month of March: Sacrament of Reconciliation



Monday, March 09 to Friday, March 19, 2021 – 7 p.m.


Come and celebrate with us the feast of St. Joseph

Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Feast Day Celebration


