- Be respectful.

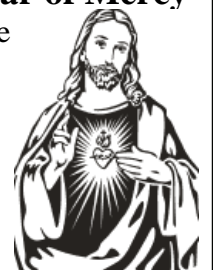
Wonder and Awe is the ability to...

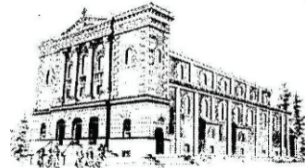
