The Good Shepherd

Pastoral Reflections by Rev. Wilson Andrade, CSC

Today in the scriptures we reflect on the beautiful image of Jesus, the Good Shepherd: a powerful image of how the shepherd is ready to give his life to save the sheep.

Through his life, death and resurrection, Jesus became our good shepherd who came to save us. In John 10:10, Jesus says ***“I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.”*** In order to give us life – life that is eternal, Jesus died on the cross and paid the price for our sins.

The Letter of Peter clearly states that ***“by his wounds you have been healed.”*** So what are we called to do? In the Acts of the Apostles it is St. Peter who proclaims the message: ***“Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”*** Then we can sing like the Psalmist who prayed in Psalm 23: ***The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.***

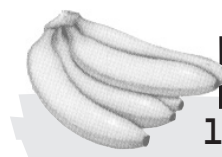
