PARKING IN KESWICK

As in years past, York Region will be allowing parking on the **EAST** (church) side of Metro Road south of First Avenue for Christmas and New Year's Masses on *December 24, 25, 31 and on January 1*. The following restrictions apply:

- Parking will be permitted on the EAST side of Metro Rd. only. For visibility reasons, parking is not permitted within 15 metres of any major intersection under any circumstances.
- 2) Parking on Metro Road is available only if all other off street parking options are at capacity.
- Vehicles must be parked in single file. No double parking will be tolerated and vehicles will be towed at owners' expense.
- 4) York Region staff will be monitoring the area to ensure that these restrictions are met.

Thank you to everyone for your cooperation in this important matter. *Please also remember that absolutely no parking is <u>EVER</u> permitted in the Fire Routes and on the shoulders of the parking lot in Keswick. York Regional Police and the Town of Georgina By-law staff WILL tow and/or ticket anyone who violates this restriction throughout the year.*
