

THE NEW TRANSLATION

THE GLORIA

When we began using the new English translation of the Roman Missal on November 27th one of the biggest changes is the words of the Gloria. When we say or sing it will not change - the Gloria is used on all Sundays of the year, except for those during Advent and Lent and a few other rare occasions. The text has changed enough that composers in Canada have written new musical settings for it that we will rehearse at times before Mass. The Gloria is a joyful hymn of praise and honour to God. When we say it or sing it we honour God's importance. In the Gloria, we raise, with one voice, the song of the angels.
