SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT. ABOUT THE ADVENT WREATH

The candles of the Advent wreath

remind us of the one for whom we are waiting, Jesus the Light of the World. The candles are purple and pink. . Purple is seen as a serious colour and the purple candles are used to remind us that preparing to welcome Jesus is serious work. Pink is seen as a joyful colour and the pink candle is used to remind us that we are preparing well to welcome Jesus and Christmas, and great joy will soon be ours. The evergreen, which is always fresh and green even in the dark of winter, remind us that the light of Jesus' love brings a peace and joy which lives in us every day and will never end. The wreath should be set in a place of honour such as the centre of a dining table. Gather around the wreath on each Sunday of Advent. As one member of your family lights the candle say a simple prayer. Today light two purples candles and you could pray the following: Jesus, You are the light of the World. May the fire of Your love burn away my sins. May it help us to prepare the way for You by helping us to be kind, forgiving and fair. Challenge for the week: Turn from selfishness. My fun. My success, My self-importance, My not being disturbed. Accept God's love, accept your lovableness, accept yourself as God has made you, accept others as brothers and sisters in Christ, accept the wonderful and continuing creation of God in yourself, in people, in the whole creation.


