# THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL 2011 ANNUAL REPORT

The SVP helped 39 families in 2011. These families consisted of 55 adults and 74 children. We also assisted 13 singles. We assisted with hydro, heat, housing, medical and transportation and emergency food vouchers. We registered 4 girls and 2 boys for summer camp. Our parish collected 70 gifts for older children through our 'Giving Tree' at Christmas.

In 2011 we received \$14,136 in donations from parishioners and from York-Simcoe Particular Council. Total money expended was \$13,997. Our opening balance was \$2,532 and our closing balance was \$2,671.
