IS THERE A GOD?

New debate series tackles life's big questions

This question will be explored at the inaugural event of the Chesterton Debate Series, sponsored by the Office of Catholic Youth and the Archdiocese of Toronto. The debate takes place on Fri., Feb. 7, at 7 pm at the Isabel Bader Theatre (93 Charles Street West). Fr. Philip Cleavelly, CO, an Oxford and Cambridge educated philosophy professor at St. Philip's Seminary, will argue the Catholic position. Representing the atheist position is Justin Trottier, the founder of the Centre for Inquiry Canada and one of the country's foremost advocates of secularism and skeptical inquiry. Stephen LeDrew, host and commentator of CP24, will moderate the debate. The series is inspired by G.K. Chesterton, an English Catholic who is widely regarded as one of the most gifted writers and orators of the 20th Century. The initiative reflects one of the core goals of the Pastoral Plan of the Archdiocese of Toronto, which challenges believers to "ensure the voice of faith is heard in the public square."
