1ST HOLY COMMUNION ENROLMENT

Enrolment will take place during all Masses this weekend and next. Attendance is only required at one of these Masses. Children will hand in their decorated sheep given out during the Reconciliation Catechetical.

ASK FATHER

Question: 'I have been to Mass at other parishes where all of the congregation stands during the Communion procession beginning at the Communion Antiphon until everyone has received Communion.' Why?

Answer: If you are to read the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) you will see the reference to standing in paragraphs 42 & 43. In part it says: A common bodily posture, to be observed by all those taking part, is a sign of the unity of the members of the Christian community gathered together for the Sacred Liturgy, for it expresses the intentions and spiritual attitude of the participants and also fosters them. We will have the GIRM available for your reference in the sacristy after Mass.

The St. Vincent de Paul Society helped 46 families in 2013. In these families there were 93 children. We also assisted 17 singles. We helped these people with hydro, heat, housing, medical and transportation costs. We also assisted with emergency food vouchers. We registered 7 girls and 2 boys for summer camp. Our parish collected many gifts for older children through our 'Giving Tree' at Christmas. Financially, in 2013, we received \$13,535 through donations from parishioners and from York - Simcoe Particular Council. We assisted people in Georgina for a total amount of \$13,990.
