


One Sunday each month at St. Michael's Cathedral at 65 Bond Street, Toronto. Vespers (evening prayer) begin at 7pm followed by Lectio Divina from 7:30 to 8:15pm. All are welcome! **Lectio Divina** ("divine, or sacred, reading") is a 2000-year-old spiritual tradition among Christians, in which they attentively and prayerfully read the word of God. We seek to be humbly attentive to God's Holy Word, to savour it, and to let it enter into our heart as much as our heads, so that it may transform us. Lectio Divina is intended to draw us closer to God, and to transform our attitudes and behaviour.

Theme for 2017: **The Freedom of the Kingdom of God**. "From that time, Jesus began to preach, saying 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Matthew 4:17 This year, we will meditate upon nine passages from the Old and New Testaments. These will illuminate the slavery we experience in the struggle with temptation and sin, and show the way to the freedom that comes from the grace of repentance and the joyful coming of His Kingdom.
