


INVALID MARRIAGES

Whenever a marriage takes place in which one or both parties are Catholic, the Catholic party is bound by the required "form" for marriage. This "form" means that whenever a Catholic person is married, they are required to be married before a priest and two witnesses. This is a precept of the Church and all Catholics have a serious obligation to observe the required form. This is an essential part of being a Catholic Christian. Civil unions are contracts of marriage but are not recognized by the faith community as covenants or sacramental unions. ROSE OF SHARON

Rose of Sharon Services for Young Mothers is a nonprofit charity dedicated to providing counselling, education, and resources to prenatal and parenting young mothers and their families in York Region.

As most of their clients do not have access to a car, and would have to spend a substantial amount of time on public transportation with a baby in tow to reach them, Rose of Sharon currently pays for cabs to help mothers access their centre. This results in over \$40,000 spent on transportation each year.

In order to reduce these costs and redirect funds towards developing our programs and services, Rose of Sharon created the Rosie's Drivers program, which recruits volunteer drivers to transport mothers and their babies to and from Rose of Sharon, which is based in Newmarket. Rose of Sharon has partnered with Routes, a non-profit organization that facilitates transportation to help individuals connect with the support and services they need to improve their quality of life. While Routes will provide training for all our volunteers, and reimburse their mileage, it is up to Rose of Sharon to recruit the volunteers.
