


We also want to continue to support the growth that has been happening in the Archdiocese of Toronto. Fourteen churches have been constructed and opened since 2000. Our growing *family of faith* means we expect this pattern continue. The cost of new churches continues to rise and this campaign will help provide for those costs by providing new parishes with an opportunity for financing through the archdiocese, allowing them to begin construction earlier in the process.

Our parish has needs too, and the funds pledged to the Family of Faith campaign will help us with the following:

- Faith formation programs, retreats and guest speakers
- Expansion of our youth ministry
- Repair of roofs at both Immaculate Conception and Our Lady of the Lake
- Masonry work at Our Lady of the Lake

Please continue to pray for the success of the campaign, both in our parish and throughout the archdiocese.
