


PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE

- Due to the continued rain this spring, the rectory roof replacement is now scheduled to start June 12th (once again weather permitting).
- The parish has been approved for a reduction in diocesan assessment rate from 15% to 5% for 18 months. A review will be conducted Oct. 31/18 to determine the progress of our financial situation.
- We are intending to hold 2 major fundraising events in the next year as the parish is running at a \$36k deficit (loss) year-to-date. If the parish wants to continue running special interest programs we have to generate more funds. We will be brainstorming community fundraising ideas with all group leaders soon. If you have any suggestions or would like to be involved, speak to Father Sherwin.
- Please consider signing up for the Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) program. Brochures will be available after Mass. It is convenient for you and provides regular and dependable flow of collections to our parish.
- Finally please consider allocating a portion of your donation to the building maintenance fund, as we currently receive a relief of diocesan assessment for these donations.
