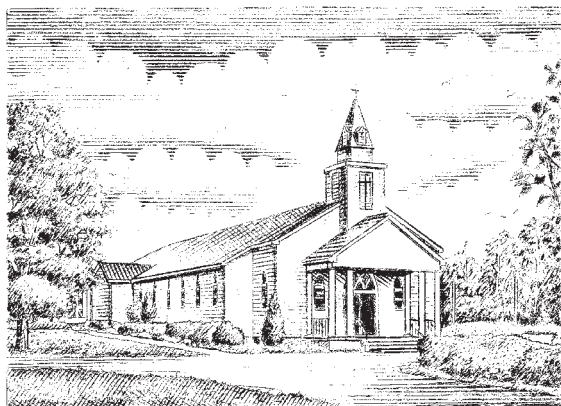
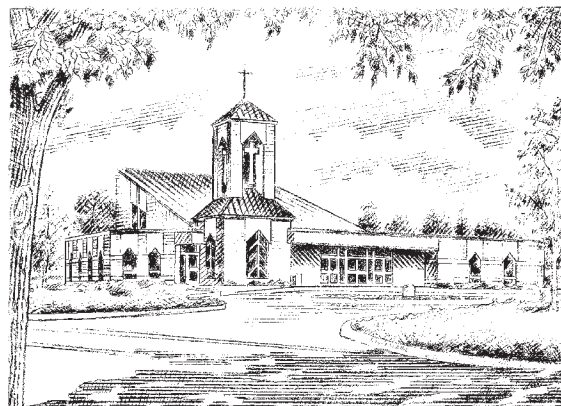

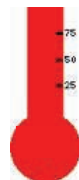

### **ST. MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL** **TEMPORARY CLOSURE**

St. Michael's Cathedral is temporarily closing its doors as part of its extensive restoration efforts that have been ongoing for 3 years. The next phase will require its closure full-time to allow for work that will preserve the cathedral for years to come. Daily Mass will be celebrated in St. John's Chapel, accessible from 200 Church St. St. Paul's Basilica will provide additional weekend Masses, featuring music from St. Michael's Choir School to accommodate the cathedral closure. A timeline has been forecast as follows:

To mid Dec. - full closure of cathedral. Mid-Dec. – Jan. 2016 - open briefly pre/post-Christmas. Jan. – Mar. 2016 - full closure of cathedral. Mar. – Sept. 2016 - cathedral will open prior to Holy Week and Easter, remaining open while work continues through Sept. 2016. Sept. 29, 2016 – goal to complete this phase of restoration. Also the Feast of St. Michael, patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto

### **GEORGINA COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY**

Again, the Georgina Community Food Pantry will be distributing school bags filled with supplies to children of families that use the food pantry. Families will be registered from mid-July to mid-Aug. Our goal is to provide 150 school bags and we are asking for your help to achieve this goal. Items needed are school bags, pencils, pens, wax crayons, hi-liters, plain folders, duotangs, 3-ring binders, lined paper, notebooks, glue, erasers & rulers. Donations can be left at either church after Mass or to the office from 9-noon Mon. to Fri. or the Food Pantry at 110 High St. in Sutton. Deadline for donations is Aug 17, which is when the bags will be packed. Thank you for your consideration in supporting this effort.



Many of the elements of the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan require no funding, but rather the investment of our time and talents. We also need to support key elements of the Pastoral Plan by investing the necessary financial resources. Family of Faith campaigns in all parishes of the archdiocese will help provide those resources.

After much thought and prayer, we have identified the following parish priorities for our share of the proceeds of the campaign: Roofs in both churches, masonry work in Keswick, etc.

The great news is that we are already well on the way to meeting our parish goal! Through the generosity of our parishioners, we have raised \$73,700.00 already from 6 families!
