


PILGRIM VIRGIN HOME VISITATION PROGRAM

CALL FOR CONSCIENCE

Bill 129, a private member bill that aimed to protect conscience rights of healthcare professionals, presented on May 18, was rejected by the Ontario legislature. What's next? Cardinal Gerhard Müller, head of the Catholic Church's theological watchdogagency, delivered the keynote address to a Canadian Catholic Bioethics Institute conference at St. Michael's Cathedral May 15.The cardinal was in Toronto to deliver the keynote address dedicated to the conscience rights of health care professionals. Muller urged members of the CCBI "to persuade Canadian citizens to take the necessary steps to reverse the dangerous legal error of your Supreme Court and Parliament, and in the meantime, to protect the rights of conscience of health care providers who refuse to take the lives of those that they have sworn to treat and comfort."

FAMILY OF FAITH

As you can see, we recently completed the roof in Sutton and are shortly having the roof in Keswick repaired.
