INSPIRATION OF HOLY SPIRIT WINDOW IN KESWICK

The Cathedra Petri, or "Throne of St. Peter", is the central work of art in the apse of St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City. Designed by Gian Lorenzo Bernini and finished in 1666, this chair is made of bronze and encases the original Chair of St. Peter, which is made of wood and ivory. The throne takes up the whole space in the front of the basilica and is centered around an amber stained glass window. At the center of this window is a white dove which symbolizes the Holy Spirit, hence the title "Dove of the Holy Spirit". The time period in which it was constructed, its oval shape, and the manipulation of light identify the window as Baroque. Interestingly, this stained glass window OF St. Peter' Basilica is not actually made of glass, but rather alabaster, a naturally translucent stone. The exact time the window was completed is uncertain, though most sources place it around 1660.
