SACRAMENT OF 1ST HOLY COMMUNION

Reminder to bring Completed Registration Form and a legible photocopy of your child's Baptismal Certificate after any Mass from October 13th/14th to November 3rd/4th.

Registration Forms will not be accepted before October 13th or after November 4th. 1st Communion Dates will be posted in both Churches as of December 1st /2nd.

First Communion Preparation Classes begin during Masses on November 3rd / 4th weekend – Held only at Our Lady of the Lake Church due to space.
