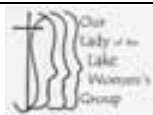

Sadly, there are not enough foster homes to accommodate these children in the Greater Toronto Area. In the words of Archbishop Thomas Collins: "*I strongly believe that more Catholic families would be open to caring for foster children if they were aware of this urgent need for foster homes. I am inviting you to seriously consider fostering, and reflect on the benefits the experience can bring to your family and vulnerable children in the community.*"
