

ROMAN MISSAL 3RD EDITION-THE NEW TRANSLATION WHEN AND HOW WILL IT BE INTRODUCED?

Parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto will begin to use the new translation of the Roman Missal on the weekend of November 27. Joining us in this journey will be Catholics in all parishes throughout Canada and the United States. You will notice many changes in the words that the celebrant (priest) uses when he celebrates Mass. There are also a few changes to the words that the congregation will use when they respond, also referred to as the "people's parts". We will also introduce new musical compositions as part of the sung Mass settings (Lord of Mercy, Gloria, Holy Holy, Lamb of God, etc.) For more information on the Roman Missal and its changes, visit

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

On Thursday, November 10th at 7pm at Our Lady of the Lake Church in Keswick we are holding an information meeting for all grade 8 students preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation and their parents. This meeting is for all children attending Our Lady of the Lake, public schools and those kids who are home-schooled. At this meeting we will outline the program. You will be required to purchase a text book at a cost of \$15.00 and a **photocopy** of your child's baptismal certificate needs to be provided (not necessary if your child was baptized at Our Lady of the Lake or Immaculate Conception.) Attendance is mandatory.
