### **Reminder!** <u>FIRST COMMUNION</u> <u>REGISTRATION DEADLINE</u> NEXT SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11<sup>TH</sup>

All parents of children in Grade 2 who attend Catholic, Public, Private, or Home School, are required to register their children for First Communion by picking up a **First Communion Registration Form** after any Sunday Mass and returning the completed form, again after Sunday Mass, by the deadline which is next <u>Sunday, October 11</u>. All parents are also required to attend a **First Communion Parent Meeting** which will be held at **7:30 p.m**. on <u>Tuesday, October 20</u> at Our Lady of the Lake Church in Keswick and on <u>Wednesday, October 21</u> at Immaculate Conception Church in Sutton after the 7:00 pm mass. Please attend whichever meeting is most convenient for you. It is important to note that if your child attends a public school, private school, or is home schooled, they are **required to attend weekly First Communion classes in the parish**. Classes will begin in October after Thanksgiving.

### Reminder! <u>CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION DEADLINE</u> <u>NEXT SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11<sup>TH</sup></u> For Parents of Children in Public School, Private School or Home School

If you are a parent of a child in Grade 8 who attends either a public or private school, or if your child is home schooled, your child will be required to attend weekly Confirmation Classes in the parish. It is imperative that you register your child in the program by picking up a **Confirmation Request Form** after any Sunday Mass, and returning the completed form, again after Sunday Mass, by the registration deadline which is next <u>Sunday, October 11</u>. As soon as class dates are confirmed, they will be published in the bulletin.
