


Common questions? Find your answer here!

- 1) What is the campaign goal? What will the money go toward? The financial goal for The Family of Faith campaign is \$105 million. Money collected will be allocated to 6 areas: parish priorities, youth, young adult ministry and campus chaplaincies, developing leaders through Catholic formation and engagement, the restoration of St. Michael's Cathedral, building new churches, and helping existing church properties.
- 2) How can I be sure that the money raised will be spent for the intended projects? A separate account has been established for money collected in the campaign. Funds will remain separate from other Archdiocesan funds and can be used only for the 6 purposes outlined above.
- 3) How are proceeds from parish campaigns allocated? 25% of funds raised, up to the parish's financial goal, are reserved for parish priorities. 75% of funds are directed toward the Family of Faith campaign's archdiocesan-wide priorities. When a parish surpasses its goal, 75% of funds above the goal are allocated for parish use. Most donations are in the form of pledges, paid over time. Funds are credited to parish accounts 2 times per year, as pledges are fulfilled.
- 4) What will I be asked to give? How will I be contacted? While we do not know your financial situation, please consider a pledge to the campaign that best complements your past sacrificial giving. A pledge allows you to consider a larger commitment than a one-time gift, and can be paid over 5 yrs. You will be contacted either in person, by phone or mail.
- 5) Why do I need to complete a pledge card? Each donor is asked to complete a pledge or commitment card, so that the gift is recorded and donors are reminded of subsequent payments on the schedule they request. A pledge is a good faith commitment, but is not binding. If circumstances change in the future, you can adjust your payment schedule or balance accordingly.
- 6) What about other priorities (eg. ShareLife) in my parish and the archdiocese? Will they be affected? Parishioners are encouraged to commit to a sacrificial gift to the Family of Faith. As the gift to the campaign is sacrificial, parishioners are asked to maintain their commitment to other priorities, and their weekly parish offertory. Large capital campaigns can have a short term impact on annual fundraising campaigns like ShareLife and this will be monitored throughout the campaign. www.ourFamily.ofFaith.ca
