ROMAN MISSAL 3rd EDITION-THE NEW TRANSLATION WHAT NEW TRANSLATION?

Did you know that the translation of the Mass which we currently use is going to change? The texts we have now have been in use since 1970 and on November 27, 2011, churches throughout North America will begin to use a new translation. This moment in the life of the church provides us with an opportunity to learn more than just words that are a little different than what we're use to. It is a chance for us to reflect on the celebration of the Eucharist and how it relates to our own life. In addition to discussing the new Roman Missal in homilies, pulpit announcements and in our parish bulletin, the Archdiocese of Toronto also has extensive resources on line for those who wish to learn more. ROMAN MISSAL 3RD EDITION-THE NEW TRANSLATION WHOSE IDEA IS IT ANYWAY?

Until the early 1960s, Mass was celebrated in Latin throughout the world. At the Second Vatican Council, in the early 1960s, it was agreed that Mass could be said in the language of the people where it was being celebrated. There would be no fundamental change to the Mass itself. just the language being used. This would enable us to understand more fully what was being said and help us to participate more fully. An English translation was made available as quickly as possible, but it was intended to be temporary. A more considered translation would be issued later. Now, some 40 years later, this translation has been approved by the Vatican and we will begin using it in our parishes on the weekend of November 27. Until that time, we will have the chance to learn more about the new translation, become familiar with some of the changes and reflect on the Eucharist in our own lives. 
ROMAN MISSAL 3RD EDITION-THE NEW TRANSLATION WORKSHOPS
