

Marriages: Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I hope and pray that you are staying healthy – both physically and spiritually. Please let me know if the parish can help during these difficult times.

Our churches are open for Mass and private prayer and we have worked diligently following guidance from public health authorities to make the environment safe for all.

If you are unable to attend in person, you are no doubt aware that our parish relies on the support of our parishioners top operate – salaries, programs and ongoing operating costs (heating, water, electricity, etc.). These are funded through the generosity of our parish community. It continues to be a challenge for our parish to maintain operations without the weekly offertory collection. We have benefited greatly from the Canada Employment Wage Subsidy, but that support is scheduled to diminish after September.

Here are the ways that you can continue to support our parish at this time:

- **Drop off or mail** your regular weekly offertory contribution to the parish office.
- Visit our Donate Now page on our websites. You choose your parish, amount of your gift – one – time or recurring and payment method – credit card or chequing account.
- **Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG)** is a monthly donation directly from your bank account. Forms are on our website or in the church.
- There is now on-line banking similar to how you may be paying your utility bills. To do this, please email <u>campaign@archtoronto.org</u>. In the body of the email provide your name, address, parish name and municipality. You will receive an email with your account information which you can use to set up the Archdiocese of Toronto as a payee in your online banking. Your gift will be forwarded to your parish. You can make a one-time or recurring gift to your offertory. This is the most cost effective way to donate electronically.
