FORMATION PROGRAMMES FOR PARISHIONERS

Formation for Sponsors in the Rite of Christian

Initiation of Adults (RCIA) – Part 1) – Have you been asked to sponsor someone who is thinking about becoming a Catholic? Would you like to mentor someone new to Christian Life? These 5 sessions, of 2 hours each, will explore the Ministry of Sponsor and will develop your gifts and the skills necessary to accompany those who wish to join our Church. Learn more about your faith, discernment, and the way the Catholic community initiates people into the Christian life; how to encourage, mentor and support someone who is being called by God to become a Roman Catholic. **Registration and pastor's approval required.** Locations: St. Gregory's at 122 Rathburn Road, Etobicoke – 5 Tuesdays, September 25 – October 23rd from 7:30 – 9:30 or Catholic Pastoral Centre at 1155 Yonge St. – 5 Wednesdays, September 26 – October 24 from 7:30-9:30pm. Lectio Divina – This runs 3 Monday mornings September 24th, October 22nd and November 26th at St. John Vianney Parish at 13 Baldwin Lane, Barrie. This Latin term means “divine reading” and is a way to read Scripture that helps us to open ourselves to hear what God is saying to us. The process moves through 4 steps: Read – a passage from the Bible is read slowly and several times; Meditate – how does this passage apply to my life?; Pray – begin the conversation with God; Contemplate – open myself to listen to God. Set aside some time to discover the spiritual rhythm in your daily life.
