

Marriages: Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

BIRTH OF OUR LADY – September 8

The Virgin Mary was born at Nazareth in Galilee from Joachim and Ann about 16 years before the birth of the Lord. They were already advanced age, and had almost lost hope that God would bless them with a child. In answer to their prayers, the Lord granted them a daughter, who was to be the Mother of the Messiah. The Feast of the Birthday of Mary originated at Jerusalem in early times, and was extended to the whole Church in 687 by Pope Sergius I. The Birth of Our Lady is closely related with her Immaculate Conception, which is celebrated on December 8, exactly nine months earlier. Many religious congregations, including the *Sons of Holy Mary Immaculate*, profess their religious vows on this day to signify their total love and commitment for the Virgin Mary.

THE PONTIFF'S SUPPORT OF SPORTS
as a TOOL OF EVANGELIZATION

It was 1908 when, in the wake of a serious economic crisis, Rome renounced hosting the Olympic Games which were eventually celebrated in London, England. In the same year Pierre de Coubertin, the founder of the modern Olympics, sought help from the Vatican to support the Games, and Pope Pius X in person offering him his support. That moment at the beginning of the 20th century is described in a book titled Pius X: The Olympics and Sports by Antonella Stelitano. At that time "less than 1% of the population practiced any sporting activity, ... and sport was used only as a form of military training or as a pastime for the upper classes," the author explained in an interview with Vatican Radio. However, "St. Pius X...was aware of the education potential of sports." He saw it as a way to approach young people, and to bring them together while following certain rules and showing respect for adversaries. One such example was in a speech that Pius X directed toward youth October 8, 1905. "I admire and bless with all my heart all the games and pastimes, gymnastics, cycling, mountain climbing, boating, jogging, (.....), competitions and academics to which you dedicate yourselves. The exercise of the body affects wonderfully on the exercise of the spirit. Because these activities require more work, you take away that sloth, which is the father of vices, and finally because the same friendly matches will be in you an image emulation in the exercise of virtue," the Pope said. "I believe," the author explained, "that he understood that it was possible to bring people together simply, without any problems of race, religion or differing political ideas." At that time in history many people did not understand the importance of exercise, said Stelitano who concluded her interview by recalling an anecdote where Pius X told one of his cardinals "All right, if it is impossible to understand that this can be done, then I myself will do exercise in front of everyone so that they may see that, if the Pope can do it, anyone can do it."
