JOHN OF THE CROSS was born in 1542 at Fontiveros in Spain. He entered the Carmelite Community and was ordained a priest in 1567. Renowned for his wisdom and sanctity, he died at Ubeda in 1591. His writings are not only classics of spirituality, but also of Spanish literature. His best known books are *The Ascent of Mount Carmel*, *The Dark Night of the Soul*, and *The Living Flame of Love*.

As we approach voting day, we must remember that ***“exercising the right to vote means making enlightened and well thought out judgement about the choices available”***. There are times when these choices may prove difficult. “ In this context it must be noted also that a well formed Christian conscience does not permit one to vote for a political program or an individual law in which the fundamental content of faith and morals is replaced by the introduction of proposals differing from this content or opposing it.” Remember we are expected to engage in ongoing dialogue on major social issues with our political leaders, since ***“we are all called to be truly responsible for one another, especially the most vulnerable members of our society.”***
