Perhaps You've Been Wondering about the role of catechist in our church. The primary role of a catechist is as a witness. Pope Paul VI wrote "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses." A Catechist must serve as a person to persons: "person-to-person contact, after the example of Jesus and the Apostles, remains indispensable. In this way, personal conscience is more easily committed. The gift of the Holy Spirit comes to the subject from one living person to another. Thus, the power of persuasion becomes more effective." (General Directory for Catechesis, no. 158) The Holy Father has designated September 25, 2016 as the Jubilee for Catechists and so we remember their work in our own community not as teachers which is the most common understanding but as witnesses to the love of Christ both with adults and children.
