Perhaps you've been wondering about which issues you should be considering in the Federal Election. The Canadian Bishops Election Guide gives some examples of the application of Catholic moral and social teaching and we will look at another of these issues this week. The heading for this week is "The person and the family". The document goes on to say that promoting the integrity of the person and family includes: promoting a better balance between familial and professional responsibilities, ensuring pay equity between men and women, guaranteeing sufficient basic income for an adequate quality of life. It also includes access to quality hospital care, reunification of immigrant and refugee families, helping immigrants to use their skills and taking action against human trafficking. It further includes the promotion of rehabilitation of criminals through restorative justice and support for victims of crime, and protecting people from addiction and gambling. Again there are many aspects to this point but they are issues that need to be on our agenda when we look at the stance of the political parties and the individual candidates.
