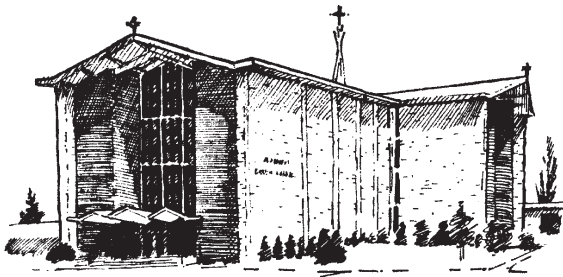

Seats will be filled from the front of the church to the back, and, after Mass, Communion will be given as you leave the church, starting with the back row. Ushers will direct the entering and exiting of the church. **REMEMBER, IF YOU EXHIBIT SIGNS OF COUGH, FEVER, SNEEZING OR ILL HEALTH, PLEASE STAY HOME.**

CHURCH OPENING Masses will be held at 9:00 a.m. Monday-Friday; 5:15 p.m. Saturday and 9:00 & 11:00 a.m. on Sunday. Confessions will be available from 4:30-5:00 p.m. on Saturday. The church will open 45 minutes prior to Mass and will be closed immediately following, so that volunteers are able to sanitize for the following Mass. The church will be closed during the day in order to maintain cleanliness for the next Mass. We regret that this has to be done, but, in keeping with provincial guidelines, it is a must. We have removed hymnals, missals, bulletins and water from the Holy Water Fonts, for your safety.
