MISSION STATEMENT



Father Cosmas' Reflection

Who is Jesus to me?

The question "Who do people say that I am?" from Matthew 16:13 holds deep significance and prompts us to consider how others perceive Jesus and His identity. This inquiry remains relevant today, encouraging us to reflect on the diverse perspectives people hold about Jesus across cultures, religions, and worldviews.

This question also prompts us to reflect on our own understanding of Jesus. How do we perceive Him? Is He merely a historical figure, a moral teacher, a prophet, or something more? Just as the disciples' answers varied, our perceptions of Jesus can be influenced by our personal experiences, upbringing, and beliefs.

Ultimately, this question serves as a springboard for Peter's profound confession: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." While people may have different opinions about Jesus, Peter's declaration highlights the central Christian belief in Jesus as the Messiah, the divine Son of God.

In our modern world, this question invites us to engage in conversations about Jesus, to explore different viewpoints, and to deepen our own understanding of His identity. It encourages us to seek a personal and authentic relationship with Him, transcending societal perceptions and connecting with the profound truth that Jesus is the Christ, the Savior of humanity.
