MISSION STATEMENT



Father Cosmas' Reflection

Transfigured in Christ

The Transfiguration of our Lord is a significant event in Christian theology, where Jesus Christ revealed His divine nature to three of His disciples, Peter, James, and John, on a mountain. This event is described in the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew 17:1-9, Mark 9:2-8, Luke 9:28-36) and is considered a pivotal moment in the life of Jesus.

Through the Transfiguration, Jesus' appearance changed, and His clothes became radiant, representing His divine glory. Moses and Elijah also appeared, symbolizing the connection between Jesus and the Law and the Prophets.

The Transfiguration offers essential lessons for believers. It reinforces the belief in Jesus' divinity and the concept of the Holy Trinity. It serves as a reminder of the importance of listening to Jesus and following His teachings.

Moreover, the Transfiguration foreshadows Jesus' death, resurrection, and ascension. It provides hope for believers that through Christ, they can attain transformation and eternal life.

As we reflect on the Transfiguration, we are encouraged to deepen our faith, embrace the mystery of Christ's identity, and strive to be transformed into His likeness through love, compassion, and selflessness.
