Introduction

On the third Sunday of Advent we light the pink candle on the Advent wreath. On this "Gaudete" Sunday we focus on expectancy and celebration, "gaudet" being a Latin word commanding us to rejoice. We celebrate together in the hope we have because, despite the evils in the world, Christ is with us.

Today's Readings

First Reading: Isaiah 35:1-6, 10

Desolate, dry places will be transformed into paradise. Creation's praise joins human praise, recognizing God's marvelous works. We daily need to renew our faltering faith.

Second Reading: James 5:7-10

James emphasizes patience, explaining, that we must wait patiently just as a farmer waits for seeds to grow.

Gospel: Matthew 11:2-11

Jesus wants to assure both John and his disciples that he is the Messiah. He also reminds them that his power is displayed in humble acts of service rather than spectacular displays of political power.

Father Cosmas' Reflection

Rejoice in the Lord always

The third Sunday of Advent is traditionally known as *Gaudete Sunday*. *Gaudete* is the Latin word meaning "rejoice." This Sunday is so named because "Rejoice" is the first word in the entrance antiphon for today's Mass taken from Philippians 4:4,5: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice! The Lord is near." This Sunday is a joyful reminder that our salvation is near. We are also reminded that Jesus comes to us at Christmas, he will bring us the good news of salvation which causes us to be joyful.

Joy, the second fruit of the Holy Spirit is one of the most visible signs of the presence of God in our lives. As His children, God desires us to manifest that joy in our lives. Christians have every reason to be joyful. We have been cleansed from our sins, we have received the good news, heaven awaits us, and we go forth in the power of the Holy Spirit. This privilege has not been granted to everyone. As Scripture states: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love Him" – 1 Corinthians 2:9. As the coming of the Saviour draws near, let us continue to wait in joyful hope for his arrival.
