

#### Introduction

We hear in the Gospel reading today how Jesus fed the crowds: he took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to them. These are the same actions that are the heart of every Mass. So Jesus feeds us today with his body and blood.

#### **Today's Readings**

#### First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Melchizedek, as priest of God Most High, brings bread and wine and pronounces God's blessing.

#### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

St. Paul tells the Corinthians how Jesus gave his disciples bread and wine as a memorial of himself.

#### **Gospel: Luke 9:11-17**

Jesus blesses and breaks bread, and hands it to his disciples to distribute among the crowds.


