# **Father Cosmas' Reflection**

#### Do not be Afraid

In sending his disciples out to proclaim the message of the kingdom and to witness to him, Jesus knew that the disciples were fearful of the fact that they would have to face persecution and hardship, challenges. He needed to encourage and strengthen them, so not once but three times he said to them 'Do not be afraid.' By offering them this encouragement, Jesus wanted to move them from fear to trust. Fear creates insecurity and distance. Trust leads to closeness, security and it gives us some sense of safety. When Jesus said to his apostles, Do not be afraid, he wasn't saying that they should never feel afraid. He was pointing at what fear might do to them. It might paralyze them, or make them so timid as to be unable to

fulfill their mission. As Christians, overcoming this fear means having complete trust in God. If God is concerned about the sparrows, we can be sure that that he is more concerned about us who are his children.


