


MISSION STATEMENT

Father Cosmas' Reflection

What a Friend we have in Jesus

In 1855, Joseph M. Scriven wrote a poem entitled-*What a friend we have in Jesus*. He wrote this poem to comfort his mother who was living in Ireland while he was in Canada. This poem was later composed into a Christian hymn by Charles Crozat Converse in 1868. The second verse of that hymn turns out to be my favorite and it reads:

"Have we trials and temptations? Is there trouble anywhere? We should never be discouraged— Take it to the Lord in prayer. Can we find a friend so faithful, Who will all our sorrows share? Jesus knows our every weakness; Take it to the Lord in prayer.

Everybody needs a friend and when Jesus is that friend. We have made the best choice in choosing a friend so faithful. In the village of Bethany Jesus had three very special friends – the sisters, Mary and Martha and their brother Lazarus. They opened their home to Jesus so that he could come in to refresh after the days work. When they became troubled because of the sickness and death of their brother Lazarus, their friend Jesus was readily available to weep, console and comfort them. Beyond that, he raised Lazarus from the dead. What a friend they had in Jesus. The desolation experienced by Mary and Martha is one many of us have experienced. In our times of trouble and desolation, we must therefore remember that our trust-worthy friend Jesus does not leave us alone. He surrounds us with his love and care just as he did for Mary and Martha.
