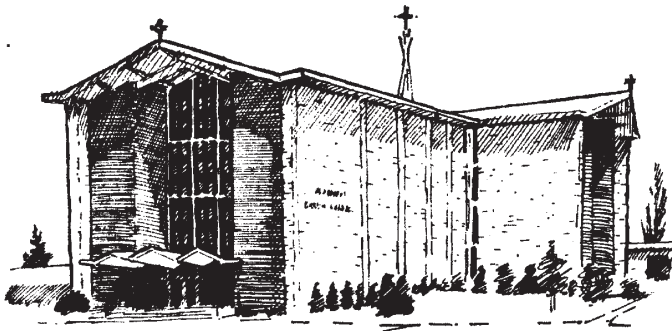

The Ascension of the Lord

“Now, as he blessed them, he withdrew from them and was carried up to heaven.”

Introduction

Luke describes the Ascension of Jesus twice: at the beginning of the Acts of the Apostles and at the end of his Gospel. The difference is that, while both depict the departure of Jesus, the Gospel is signalling the end of Jesus’ time on earth, whereas Acts signals the beginning of the mission of the Church.

Today’s Readings

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11

Following a formal dedication of the book to his patron, Theophilus, Luke tell the story of Jesus’ Ascension.

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23

This concentrates on what faced Jesus after his Ascension – to sit at the right hand of God.

Gospel: Luke 24:46-53

After Jesus’ Ascension, the disciples are overjoyed, even though he has departed. They spend their time praising God in the Temple.
