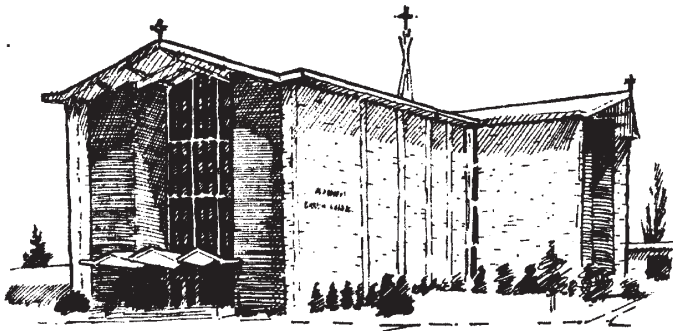

## Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

*“Being children of the resurrection  
they are sons of God.”*

### Introduction

Sadducees, like most Jews around Jesus' time, did not believe in the resurrection of the dead. Many Pharisees, in contrast, did believe in it, as, of course, did Jesus and followers. But the Sadducees would not give in easily.

### Today's Readings

#### First Reading: 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14

In this book, new ground is broken in that people are prepared to die rather than submit to pagan worship, because they believe that the virtuous rise to new life, which will never end.

#### Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 2:16; 3:5

Paul reminds his readers that God is faithful and will guard them and keep them safe even if difficulties exist.

#### Gospel: Luke 20:27-38

Sadducees did not believe that the dead rise; many Pharisees did believe in the resurrection. It is strange to learn that Pharisees could actually agree with Jesus on occasion.

**Father Cosmas' Reflection**

**The Road to Eternal Life**

On November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> we celebrated the solemnity of All Saints and the commemoration of All Souls. These two celebrations remind us of our journey to the promised land of eternal life. This Sunday, the liturgy is dominated with the assurance of an afterlife.

Eternal life is a life that is lived with God in heaven forever. By dying and rising from the dead, Jesus fulfilled this promise. The journey to eternal life begins at baptism. As Christians, we begin to experience eternal life even before we die. By giving our lives to Jesus and by loving Him with all our hearts, all our souls, all our minds, and all our strength (see Lk 10:27), we live this promised eternal life.

When we draw near to God and receive his peace, when he heals our broken relationships, when we catch glimpses of God's justice in the world, we receive a foretaste of the life to come.
